**SECTION- I****PUTHIMARI COLLEGE : A BRIEF PROFILE**

Puthimari College, a premier institution of higher education in Puthimari area was established on August 5, 1981. Being situated on the bank of river Puthimari in Kamrup (R), the backward transportation and communication system hinders the college in its prosperity. This clearly shows that higher education was beyond the dream of the area. As good luck would have it, the emergence of the College by the Puthimari River comes forward to fulfill the long-felt thirst for higher education of the young generation. Presently, the academic activities of the institution widen beyond the territory of the district. It is now acknowledged as one of the pioneers of higher education in Assam. Meanwhile, the College has achieved "B" grade in NAAC Re-accreditation in 2012.

The College stands at Soneswar by the Puthimari River in the district of Kamrup. It is only 40 km away to the north of Guwahati, the capital city of Assam. 31 No. National Highway connects the college by a PWD road at Baihata. It is in a sylvan area with the Puthimari River in the west and the wetland of Alta in the east.

The College has enough provision for class rooms, departments, well equipped library and student union hall etc. The College has also Sufficient provisions for games and sports for the students. It is now on its way to set up a digital classroom and e-learning room to facilitate the students with the taste of knowledge world wide. Hostel facility for girl students are being made available soon.

**SECTION - III**

**ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

Application for admission into the College should be made in the prescribed application form issued by the College office on payment of Rs. 50.00 only.

- ❖ Students will be selected for admission strictly on merit.
- ❖ The College follows the government rules of reservation for admission of the students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MOBC.
- ❖ A few seats are also reserved for physically handicapped students and for the students having outstanding achievements in sports, cultural field and NCC.
- ❖ Application forms should be accompanied by attested copies of required document.

**➤ Free Studentship:**

The College provides free studentship (except GU and AHSEC fees) to ten students, five for H.S. 1<sup>st</sup> year and five for B.A. 1<sup>st</sup> semester, hailing from BPL group. For this purpose the students will be required to produce attested copy of BPL certificate along with application form. Selection in this regard shall be on merit basis.

**➤ Document in origin to be produced at the time of interview and admission.**

- (a) Marksheet of the last qualifying examination.
- (b) Transfer certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
- (c) Caste certificate in case of OBC, MOBC, SC, and ST applicants.
- (d) Students passing the qualifying examination earlier than the current year will have to submit a gap certificate from the head of the institution last attended.
- (e) One copy of passport size (not attested) photograph for identity card.

- e. Students must park their vehicles in the area allotted for the purpose.
- f. Ragging in any form inside and outside the campus is strictly prohibited.

#### ☉ Activities for Physical and mental fitness

The College provides facilities which are commonly necessary for physical and mental fitness of the student. Games and sport activities are regularly performed under the guide ship of an in-charge for the teachers from the teachers against each category of activities – physical as well as mental. The College hold weeklong programme of games, sports literary, talent charge and cultural competitive mend and to select the efficient students in each category. The College playground accommodates the important matches like football, valley ball, badminton etc. games races and jumps of different types. Competitions indoor games and literacy and cultural events are also held annually. The proficient one from any event get chance to join in University level or state level competitions.



➔ **Seminar**

There is a provision of conducting student oriented departmental seminar by every department. For cognitive development of the students departmental seminars are organised in which participation of students is mandatory.

➔ **Academic Calendar**

Curricular and co-curricular activities of the College are conducted as specified in the academic calendar of the session. Students must follow the guidelines of the academic calendar throughout the session.

**SECTION- VI**

**STUDENTS' WELFARE SCHEMES AND FACILITIES**

(a) **Library and reading room facility**

The college has a well equipped and computerised central library. There are Sufficient Number of Text and Reference Books. There are also a few current journals which are basically subject oriented, health and sports related. The Library is provided with a reading room with seat capacity for a good number of students at a time. Students can also avail easy excess to daily news by using news paper stand of the library.

Besides, the college library has a provision to assist a advance students from BPL family by providing text books over and above regular borrowing of books from the book bank of the college.

The students can also borrow books from the respective departmental libraries.

***The library remains open from 9.00 A.M. to 5 P.M.***

(b) **Book Bank facility**

The college has **book bank facility**. The book bank lends books to the meritorious students with poor financial background. Students willing to avail themselves of this opportunity should apply to the librarian in prescribed form.

**N.B.:-** To encourage the reading habit of the students the librarian of the College has been offering a "**Best Reader Award**" to the student annually.

(c) **News Paper reading stands**

The students can access to the daily news papers of different kind by going to the news reading desk provided with the central library.

(d) **Scholarship**

The College distributes national, state merit, minority community and SC/ST/OBC/MOBC Scholarship as per the rules laid down by the government.

(e) **Awards**

For the Academic encouragement of the students, two cash awards are offered annually by the College authority to the Best Graduate and the Best H.S. Scholar respectively.

Another award is offered by Dr. A. D. Baruah to the H.S. Scholar/scholars securing highest marks in Assamese (MIL) in the last H.S. Examination.

**N.B.:-** A minimum of 60% marks has to be obtained in order to qualify for these awards.

(e) **Students' Aid Fund**

The college provides financial assistance to the students hailing from poor economic background. Deserving students shall have to apply to the Principal stating his/her economic background alongwith a certificate from Gaonburah or Mauzadar of the locality and a photocopy of the ration card of the family. In this regard the students will have to contact the students aid fund disbursement committee.



(f) **Internet Facility**

Internet and printing facility is available in the College at free of cost for the College family according to urgency.

(g) **Boys' and Girls' Common Room**

There are separate Common rooms for boys and girls. The students may avail recreational facilities with the available indoor and outdoor equipments.

(h) **Publication**

The student community publishes an annual magazine "Puthimarian" by which they can focus their efficiency in literary works. Moreover, some of the departments publishes departmental magazines which can help the student to publish their important writings.

(i) **Carrier guides and Counselling**

Students can avail the facility of carrier guidance from the carrier guidance cell of the College and can have proper counselling from the committee of the cell headed by Professor of the College.

(j) **Remedial coaching centre**

Presently, the College has been running a remedial coaching programme through which weak students are coached by extra classes during off time and holi days.

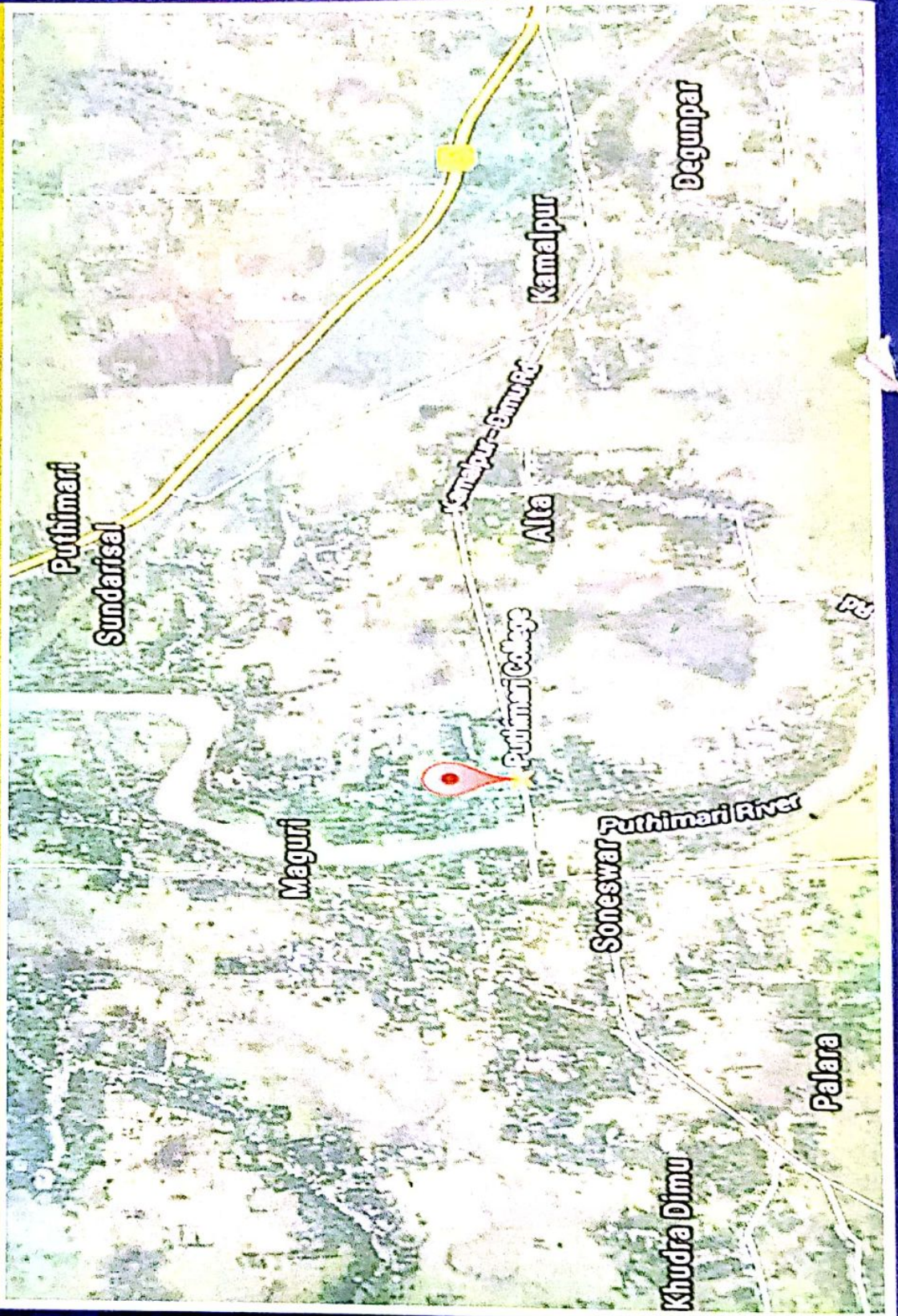
